ORDINANCE NO. 2023- 22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FERDINAND MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING PARK LEASES AND FEES

WHEREAS, the Town charges a fee for reserved exclusive use of park facilities; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Ferdinand Park Board that the fee for the exclusive use of the 18th St. or 5th St. Park be increased to \$500.00 per day; and

WHEREAS, the State Board of Accounts wishes this fee be set by Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

- 1. Ferdinand Municipal Code Section 1.06.070 Fees is amended as follows:
- **"1.06.070 Fees.** The Board may authorize use of specific park facilities pursuant to terms, conditions and regulations as established from time to time by the Board, and for the fees as hereinafter set forth:

1.06.070 FEES

(1) Entire 5th Street or 18th Street Park (includes shelter houses, volleyball courts, ball fields, horseshoe pits, etc.) \$500.00 per day

(2) 1 Ball field (more than one ball field Required entire park rental) \$100.00 per day

(3) Basketball court	\$ 15.00 per day
(4) Volleyball Court	\$ 15.00 per day
(5) Horseshoe pit-18th St or 5th St	\$ 15.00 per day
(6) Volleyball Court with Lights	\$ 25.00 per day
(7) 18th St. Shelter House-any	\$ 50.00 per day
(8) 5th St. Shelter House	\$ 50.00 per day
(9) Old Town Lake Shelter House	\$ 50.00 per day

The Board is authorized to enter into leases from time to time for multifacility and multi-date use for fees the Board considers appropriate considering the length and nature of the use and which may combine fields and shelter houses or use of all park facilities on one or more dates."

2. All other provisions of Chapter 1.06 shall remain unchanged. The Clerk-Treasurer shall cause this Ordinance to be published as required by law. This Ordinance shall be effective January 1, 2024, upon adoption and publication as required by law for the 2024 leases and thereafter.
