

Ferdinand Park & Recreation Board Minutes

April 3, 2019

Regular monthly meeting of Ferdinand Park and Recreation Board was held on Wednesday, April 3 in the town hall beginning at 4:33 p.m. In attendance were Matt Weyer, Mike Steffe, Natalie Howard, Dolores Boeglin and Tom Lueken.

Minutes were approved with motion by Mike and second by Natalie; expense report also approved with motion by Matt and second by Mike.

Reporting on the Old Town Lake project stated that the town council had approved the bid. Start date is scheduled for the first part of June. All trees along the trail are down and cleanup will be done in approximately two days. Several items were mentioned as possible Eagle Scout projects at the Old Town Lake.

A discussion was held on the lease rates for the parks for the year 2020. Mike made a motion to adopt the modified leases with a second by Natalie.

Tenbarger has completed work on the 5th St. girls field. The league requested that the board cut the sod back on both fields. Tom will install the structure for netting as soon as the weather gets better as a bucket truck will be needed to install this. Also Green Thumb will be maintaining the sprinklers.

Mike made a motion to tape the basketball court for pickle ball. Tom also reported that 18th St. Park is being used quite a bit. He is also in the process of hiring summer help.
