Wednesday, April 4, 2018

Regular meeting of Ferdinand Park & Recreation Board was held on Wednesday, April 4 beginning at 4:30 p.m. in the town hall with Matt Weyer, Mike Steffe, Dolores Boeglin and Tom Lueken in attendance.

Minutes and expense reports were approved with a motion by Mike and seconded by Matt.

Tom reported that 10 trees instead of the 8 Autumn Blaze Maples would be planted and tree maintenance will begin as soon as weather permits.

Erin Riley had requested the board to do some maintenance work on the girls little league field to help with low spots. Tom suggested that a short term remedy would be to fill needed areas when dry enough to get a small truck on the field at the park's expense. This was approved.


Rob Randle requested use of 18th St. field for the girls' traveling league. He was given approval as long as it isn't leased. It is always on first-come basis.
