

TOWN OF FERDINAND

MEETING

July 25, 2023

The Ferdinand Town Council met for a Public Meeting at 6:00 AM on Tuesday, July 25, 2023, in the Ferdinand Town Hall and during that public meeting additionally attended to certain business that had arisen since the regular July Meeting. That consideration began at 1:10 PM and concluded at 1:35 PM. Present were Council President, Ken Sicard; Vice-President, Debbie Johnson; Council Member, Ron Weyer; Attorney, Sharon Bohnenkemper and Clerk-Treasurer, Tamara Miller.

Debbie moved to approve the proposal from Universal Design for the two phases of design services to aid with the Community Crossing Matching Grant 2023-02, the Grant Planning and Application Phase Fee of \$7,400 and the Final Design and Bidding Phase Fee of \$10,500. Ron seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Ron moved to approve the hiring of a part-time office employee, working 3 days a week starting at the end of August at the rate of \$22.00 per hour, contingent upon passing the drug test. Debbie seconded. Motion carried 3-0. Ken moved to include prorated holidays. Debbie seconded. Motion carried 3-0.


Debbie moved to approve the Survivors of Suicide of Dubois County request for a Town of Ferdinand Proclamation declaring the month of September as National Suicide Prevention Month, contingent upon Sharon's review of the document. Ron seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Ron moved to adopt Ordinance 2023-12, stating that any full-time employee of the Town of Ferdinand who volunteers to be a member of and performs services (fire runs) for the Volunteer Fire Department of the Town of Ferdinand shall be paid by the Fire Department for the fire run and by the Town of Ferdinand as regular payroll if the fire run is during his/her normal hours of employment. This is limited to 200 hours during any calendar year. Debbie seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

The discussion of the budget then resumed.
