

ORDINANCE NO. 2022- 19

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9.08 OF THE
FERDINAND MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING DESIGNATED 4-WAY STOP STREETS**

WHEREAS, the Town Council is empowered to enact such ordinances as it deems necessary to promote public health, safety, conform, morals, convenience, and the general public welfare of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council considers it necessary and prudent for the well being of the municipality and has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town that a four-way stop be erected at the intersection of 9th Street and Virginia.

WHEREAS, the Town Council believes that having a four-way stop at the above-referenced intersection will result in reduced speeds on Ninth and create better visibility at that intersection and thus promoting the health and safety of citizens of the Town as a whole.

WHEREAS, the Town Council has received advice from the public, its Police Chief, and its Property and Street Department Superintendent, and its engineer with respect to projected and current traffic volume, patterns and characteristics at or near 9th and Virginia; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that Ninth Street at Virginia (both directions) and Virginia at Ninth (both directions) shall be designated as a four way stop.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FERDINAND TOWN COUNCIL:

1. Section 9.08.020 of the Ferdinand Municipal Code is hereby amended to add the following designated 4-way Stop Streets:

“(154) Virginia at Ninth – both directions

(155) Ninth at Virginia – both directions


2. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as required by law.




