TOPIC: Fall Clean-Up 2018

Again this year, the Street Department will be providing pick-up of large bulky items during Fall Clean-Up.

Monday, October 8th, 2018 will be normal household trash pick up. All bags with trash stickers should be at curbside no later than 7:00 AM.

Tuesday, October 9th, 2018 large items will be picked up on West side of Town and on Wednesday, October 10th, 2018 large items will be picked up on East side. Please have the items at the curb by 7:00 a.m. If needed, will finish pickup Thursday, October 11th, 2018. Items made of metal picked up at no charge include, but not limited to: electric or gas ranges, refrigerators, washers, dryers, deep freezers, water heaters, lawn mowers, bicycles, etc. The following items and their fees will be billed to the resident if picked up: any wooden chair (\$11); any couch (\$11); small TV (\$10); medium (\$15) & large TV (\$25); computer processor (\$6); computer monitor (\$6); computer printer (\$6); mattress (\$11); box springs (\$11); any other furniture item made of wood (\$11); any car tire (\$5); passenger size truck tire (\$15); semi tire (\$15); tractor tire (\$40) each (add \$5 for tires on rims); small 20lb LP gas cylinders (\$5); Toilet (\$6), Sink (\$6), Fluorescent lamps (\$1.00/ each for small spiral bulbs, 4 foot, circle & compact) and (\$1.50/each for 8 foot & U-shaped). Small electrical appliance (radios, toasters, coffee makers, etc...) (\$5), microwaves (\$8), dehumidifier (\$8), window AC units (\$8). Certain items (Examples: doors, large piles of wood items, carpet in 4ft length roll etc.) not listed above may have a fee, which will be determined by the Ferdinand Street Dept. Other items not listed will be hauled to the landfill and the Town will be charged at a per tonnage rate.

***** At no time, including Fall Clean-Up, will free flowing liquids such as oil or paint be picked up, since the landfill does not accept these items.**

For safety reasons, no refrigerators or freezers will be picked up if the door is not removed from the unit. Also, no units containing Freon will be picked up without a technician's certificate stating that the Freon has been removed (includes dehumidifiers and AC units). This certificate may be securely affixed to the unit.
