Economic Development Commission Meeting

April 15, 2019

The Ferdinand Economic Development Commission held its regular monthly meeting on April 15, 2019, in the Ferdinand Town Hall. Members present included Dan Collignon (President), Roger Corley, and Michael Cummings (Secretary). President Collignon called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m.

The first order of business was to welcome new Commission member Roger Corley.

Collignon moved to accept the March 18, 2019, meeting minutes as presented.


Cummings seconded, and the motion was approved with Corley abstaining due to the fact he was not yet a member during the March 18 meeting.

Collignon and Cummings briefed Corley about the Commission's past initiatives. Of particular note were those activities relating to residential development, including identifying land suitable for development, communication and meetings with property owners and developers, a housing survey conducted in 2017, and the recent approval of a loan fund to be used for the construction of streets within approved housing development projects.

Cummings agreed to draft a press release to advertise the program now that it has been formally adopted into the Town's budget.

With no further business to come before the Commission, Cummings moved to adjourn. Collignon seconded the motion, which carried unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 6:55 p.m.
