

ORDINANCE NO 0-75-4

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SYSTEM OF HOUSE
AND BUILDING NUMBERING THROUGHOUT THE TOWN
OF FERDINAND

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Ferdinand that there is now hereby established and adopted a system for numbering houses, buildings, structures and lots appropriate for future improvements throughout the streets in the Town of Ferdinand.

Section 1. All lots, houses, buildings and structures in the Town shall be numbered in accordance with the following plan:

- a. All lots, houses, buildings and structures facing "Named" Streets will be numbered corresponding to the number Street; and on the West side of said Street will end in a "5", and on the East side of said Street will end in "0".
- b. All lots, houses, buildings and structures facing "Numbered" Streets, will be divided from Main Street as to East and West. The first block in each direction will be the "100" block, the second in each direction will be the "200" block, etc.
- c. To the East of Main on the Numbered Streets, the numbers on the South side will end in "1" and the numbers on the North side will end in "2".
- d. To the West of Main on the Numbered Streets, the numbers on the South side will end in "3" , and the numbers on the North side will end in "4".
- e. All upstairs apartments will end in "½" added on to the corresponding address.

Section 2. The Town Clerk-Treasurer shall have in his custody a chart or map drawn for the purpose of showing the proper street number of every lot in the Town which shall be open to inspection by anyone interested.

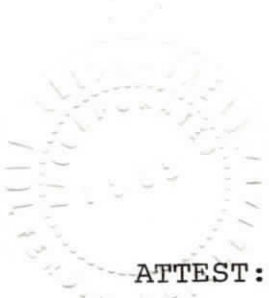
Section 3. It shall be the duty of the owners and occupants of every house, building or structure in the Town to have placed thereon within *Six (6) months* of the first publication of this Ordinance, in a place visible from the street, figures at least two and one-half inches high, showing the number of the house, building or structure; any person, firm or corporation failing to so number any house, building or other structure occupied by him, or if after receiving notice to do so from the clerk shall continue in his failure to so number such house, building or structure shall be fined one dollar (\$1.00) for each day during or on which a failure to so number continues.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication thereof in a newspaper of general circulation throughout the Town for not less than two (2) consecutive weeks, as required by law.
